

When does Curbside Collection occur in Downtown Barrie?

Garbage Collection: Every Tuesday and Friday



BUSINESSES: 6 bags per week.



RESIDENTS: 1 bag per week.

Recycling Collection: Tuesday only



BUSINESSES: 1 grey bin and 4 blue bins per week.



RESIDENTS: unlimited.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

All waste containers must be placed out for collection no earlier than 4 p.m. the day prior to collection and all waste containers must be removed by the property owner, business or tenant along with any uncollected waste, no later than 4 p.m. on the designated day of collection.

Effective Nov. 6, 2017: If any waste is left out after 4 p.m. on the day of collection, a crew from the City's Roads, Parks and Fleet department will collect the waste and issue a formal warning to the property owner. If the City is required to collect waste from the same property a second time, an invoice for the cost of clean-up will be issued to the owner of the property. Continued violations may also result in legal action in addition to invoicing for the cost of removal.

Please ensure your tenants and staff are aware of the Waste Collection rules in the Downtown Barrie BIA. Together, we can help keep downtown beautiful.

What time can I put my waste out?

In an effort to keep Downtown Barrie looking clean and presentable, please wait until at least 4 p.m. on the day before collection to put your waste out at the curb. Collection occurs between 4 a.m. and 6 a.m. on Tuesday and Friday.

How much garbage can I put out each week?

Businesses: Maximum of six bags/cans of garbage (up to 45 lbs. each).

Residents: 1 bag/can of garbage (up to 45 lbs).

How much recycling can I put out each week?

Businesses: Maximum of five bundles of cardboard per week (tied and bundled no larger than 75 cmx75cmx20cm), one grey recycling box for paper and up to four blue boxes for container items (glass, cans and plastics).

Residents: Unlimited blue and grey boxes, but must be separated properly. Cardboard must be tied and bundled no larger than 75 cmx75cmx20cm.

Where do I get a recycling bin?

Recycling boxes are available at no charge at the Environmental Centre (272 Ferndale Drive North) Tuesday to Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Why didn't my waste items get collected?

Waste items will not be collected if they are not in compliance with the above Waste Collection rules or were not put out on time. If your waste was put out on time, but was not collected it will have a non-compliance notice attached to it.
