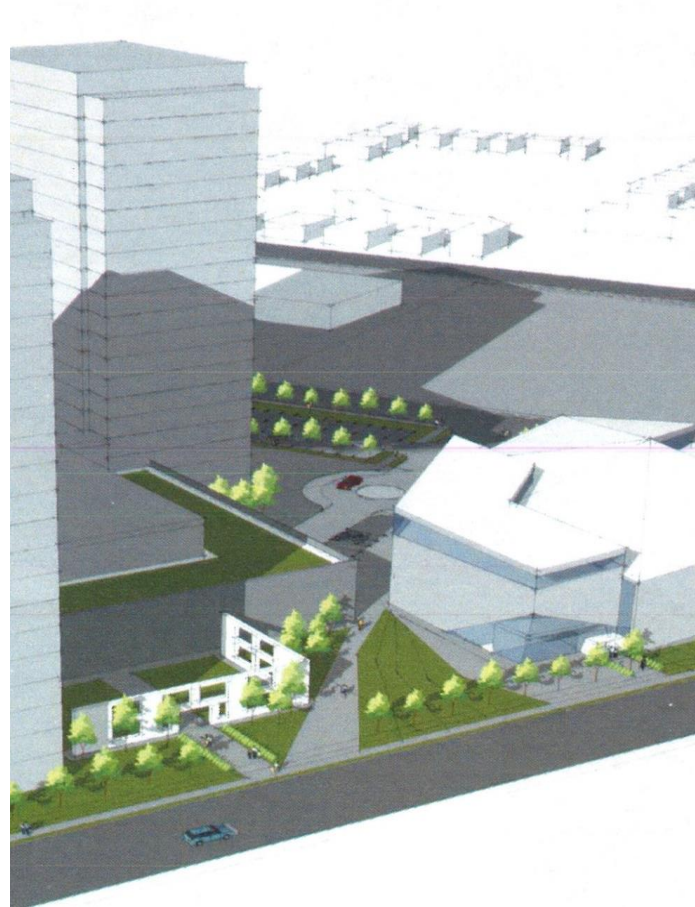
A New Kind of Y – Partner in Developing our Downtown Core

We have a signed Agreement of Purchase and Sale for property along Bradford Street beside the former Prince of Wales Public School



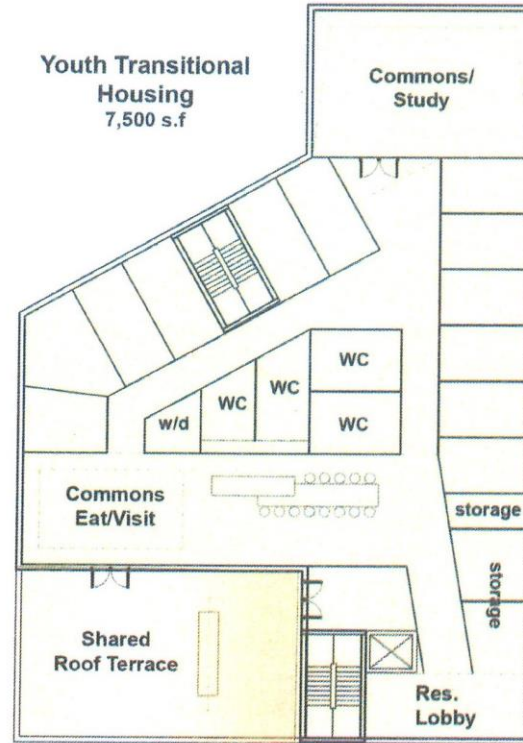
