Health and Safety:

Hoarding fencing and signage has been placed and erected in the preliminary phase, from west side of Mulcaster Intersection East to the Project limit (Poyntz Street).

Proper protective equipment shall be worn at all times, inside the work area.

Pedestrian Traffic and Deliveries will be directed by the Safety Ambassadors on site.

All vehicular traffic is now being detoured around the work area.

Access through the work area will only be for emergency vehicles and local residence as well as prearranged deliveries with the Public Relations Officer.

Description of Work Completed Today:

Continuation of Water Main installation

Description of Work Planned for Tomorrow:

Continuation of Water Main installation. Removal of more asphalt and structures.

Business Access Affected:

All stores will be accessible via pedestrian walkways with no planned interruptions in the walkway area August 27th to August 28th.

Access to Residential Condominiums @140 Dunlop, @150 Dunlop Street and Commercial Plaza @149 Dunlop to be via **Mulcaster Street Entrance of the hoarding fencing.**

Deliveries for all businesses located between Poyntz and Mulcaster to be coordinated with the Project Public Relations Officer -Nicole Maurice (705) 794-7800.

Special Requirements of Businesses or Residents:

Garbage to be collected as per usual schedule.

Water Shut off Thursday August 29th, 2019 for 130 to 150 Dunlop Street East.

Access to 140, 150, and 149 Dunlop Street will only be from the Mulcaster side of the hoarding fencing.
