## Health and Safety:

Hoarding fencing and signage has been placed and erected in the preliminary phase and Phase 1A, from the East side of Owen and Dunlop Intersection East to the Project limit (Poyntz Street).
Proper protective equipment shall be worn at all times, inside the work area.
Pedestrian Traffic and Deliveries will be directed by the Safety Ambassadors on site.
All vehicular traffic is now being detoured around the work area.
Access through the work area will only be for emergency vehicles and local residence as well as prearranged deliveries with the Public Relations Officer.

## Description of Work Completed Today:

Additional hoarding fencing to be placed from Mulcaster Street and Dunlop Street intersection to Owen Street and Dunlop Street Intersection, to commence phase 1A (between Owen Street and Mulcaster Street).
Removal of asphalt and structures (benches, light standards).

## Description of Work Planned for Tomorrow:

Removal of Asphalt and structures
Water Main Connection.

## Business Access Affected:

All stores will be accessible via pedestrian walkways with no planned interruptions in the walkway area September $9^{\text {th }}$ to September $10^{\text {th }}$.
