- Input into City planning
- Community engagement & education





# **2019 Opportunity – Bob Hunter Memorial**



- 3 places for public art included in Meridian Place build (foundations)
- Family of Bob Hunter offered contribution of \$50,000 for public art in Meridian, in his honour
- Barrie Central Alum, lifelong passion for music, played in several bands
- Bob Hunter was a strong supporter of outdoor facility on waterfront for live music – submitted proposal to Trillium
- BPAC would raise a matching \$50,000
- Piece would be commissioned based on guidelines from BPAC Committee






### **City Guidelines**

- EMT and Council Review of short-listed concepts
- EMT and Council Review of final commission and placement
- Must not be a "Memorial" i.e. bust or monument; intended to be public art
- · Contributions must adhere to sponsorship guidelines
- Any proposed donor recognition signage must be reviewed and approved by City staff
- Funds must cover the commission as well as required maintenance; ideally cover specific installation costs and any amenities
- Engagement of BIA and Meridian Working Group to ensure alignment with intention of space



## Ask to BIA: Engagement

- · Participation on BPAC Committee
  - Define look, feel, placement
  - Review and judge submissions
  - Support recommendations to Council
  - Coordinate on fundraising to ensure Meridian donors are not approached again
- Proposed Timeline
  - Staff Report to Council March 18th
  - Fundraising March June
  - Committee formed to develop call March June
  - Fall Release of call
  - Q1 2020 Selection of Concept and Artist
  - Q4 2020 Installation
