# STAFF UPDATE - Executive Director Craig Stevens

- Mr. Stevens provided an overview of the 'Staff Report' shared with the Board and noted the following...
  - Noëlla Festival -
    - Background:
      - Downtown Barrie has been awarded a grant of over \$30,000 for this year's Noella Festival.
        - This funding should allow the BIA to replicate something similar to last year's Noëlla Treelighting concert with the Stumbellas.
    - Discussion:
      - Mr. Stevens shared some of the perimeters of the grant, including using the funds to facilitate a two-day event.
        - The Board quickly brainstormed some ideas for two days.
    - Next Steps:
      - The BIA will strike a 'Sub Committee' to help facilitate the events over the two days, such as a 'Maker Market'.

# • Royal Victoria Hospital (RVH) 's Healthy Living Initiative -

- Background:
  - Downtown Barrie has met RVH to discuss their 'Healthy Living' initiative, which would partner the hospital with Downtown restaurants/chefs to promote healthy options on their menus.
    - It would also promote family-friendly outdoor activities in downtown and the waterfront, and tie together the City's Community Safety Plan and food insecurity initiatives, etc
- Next Steps:
  - Mr. Stevens will pull together details on the initiative and share with the Board.

# • Original Butter Tart Celebration -

- Background:
  - Vice-Chair Steve Ricalis and BIA Staff recently met with the organizer of the regional Butter Tart festivals to discuss hosting an event next year in Downtown Barrie; possibly on July 13 or July 20, 2024.
    - There is an opportunity to partner with the RVH Foundation.
- Discussion:
  - The Board brainstormed opportunities for events within the event, along with promotion and advertising concepts, and thoughts about the makeup of the vendor artisan market.
