CHAIR'S REMARKS - Vice-Chair Steve Ricalis

- Every Open Air Dunlop should have a theme or as much activation as possible. If the Board has to reduce the number of weekends in order to have more impact, then we do until we fill up the street with activation and keep on building up from there.
 - Next Summer, Mr. Ricalis would love to do eight (8) or six (6) events, but the important factor is to ensure that there is something significant going on in conjunction with each event to draw thousands of people downtown.
 - Director Chis Gerrard added he feels that the BIA should be careful when hosting Open Air Dunlops in the early and later in the season because of weather and the later months and suggested focusing on the summer months.

 - Background:
 - An interesting concept was presented at the International Downtown Association Conference a couple of weeks ago,
 - It has six (6) or seven (7) items listed on how people use the downtowns, such as 'live', 'work', 'play', 'make', 'create', 'meet', and 'socialize; and how pre-COVID and post-COVID uses have changed significantly.
 - 'Shopping' was dropped and 'play' increased.
 - Downtowns that would have been considered a 'central business district' pre-COVID are now being considered a 'central social district' post-COVID people are coming downtown to 'play'..

 - The Board briefly discussed the opportunity, as well as the opportunity to partner with other major events such as Kempenfest to activate the Meridian Place Stage.
